Prior to founding jetAVIVA, Mr. Marcus served as a flight test engineer for Eclipse Aviation, maker of the Eclipse 500 very light jet. Mr. Marcus is an FAA-certified Airline Transport Pilot and Flight Instructor with more than 4,500 hours of flight experience in more than 100 types of airplanes, seaplanes, gliders, and helicopters. He has been a volunteer for Angel Flight West for more than 20 years and serves on its board of directors.
