Eduardo Dominguez Puerta, recently nominated as Head of Urban Air Mobility (UAM), and prior to this in charge of Business Innovation within Airbus Strategy & International, is tasked to lead and coordinate various UAM activities on divisional and corporate level.

As the founder COO Eduardo has helped to build A³ by Airbus, a centre for advanced and disruptive projects in Silicon Valley.

During his 15+ years of aeronautical experience Eduardo has seen through the development of several commercial aircraft programmes and contributed to the manufacturing of more than 4,000 airplanes. He trained as an industrial engineer at ICAI (Universidad Pontificia de Comillas in Madrid), TUM (Technical University of Munich), and later enjoyed PhD lectures on Business Administration at Politecnica de Madrid and continuous studies at Stanford.

Eduardo joined Airbus in 2002, after a brief stint at a Big Four consulting firm. A polyglot, Eduardo is an Airbus-made product, representing present and future generations of executives.

Eduardo also served as Chairman of the Board of Alestis Aerospace, a Spanish aerostructure supplier, and Voom Ltd, global air mobility operator.

Airbus is the merged entity between Airbus Group and Airbus which took effect on 1st January 2017. The former Airbus division is now referenced Airbus Commercial Aircraft.
