



Dr. Jim Paunicka is a Boeing Technical Fellow and senior researcher in the Boeing Research & Technology organization, focusing on the technical areas of unmanned systems and autonomy. He is currently supporting the Boeing Defense, Space & Security (BDS) business unit, the Boeing Commercial Airplanes (BCA) business unit, the Boeing HorizonX innovation organization, and Boeing Phantom Works in their autonomy efforts and investment evaluations.
